Admission Procedure

- The Admission process starts immediately after the declaration of Class-XII results of major national Boards recognized by Jadavpur University.
- A student who is selected for enrolment in a particular course offered by the College will have to complete the admission procedure and get herself registered within the notified time period.
- Application for admission has to be made on the prescribed form obtained from the office of the Institute, on the designated days (Monday to Friday between 10:00 am and 1:00 pm and again from 1.30 p.m to 3.00 p.m, and Saturday, 10.a.m to 12 noon) only. Students may also apply online.
- Application forms are non-transferable.
- Form must be collected in the name of the applicant only.
- Forms should be complete in all respect with coloured passport size photo pasted firmly on appropriate boxes
- Cost of the Application Form is Rs. 1,300/- only. Online applicants can pay the money (Rs. 1,500/-) through NET Banking, Debit Card, or Credit Card

ELIGIBILITY

1. Only female candidates are eligible for admission to the B.Com (Hons) course.
2. Candidates must have good knowledge of the English language.
3. A candidate seeking admission to three year B.Com (Hons.) course of the Institute must have passed Class-XII examination of any recognized Board / Council recognized by Jadavpur University with a combination of four recognized subjects of which at least one is English and securing at least 50% marks in the aggregate.
4. Foreign Students may be admitted as per Jadavpur University norms.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

1. Candidates eligible for the B.Com (Hons) courses would be short-listed based on the following criteria:
