ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- The Admission process starts immediately after the declaration of Class-XII results of major National Boards recognized by Jadavpur University.
- A student who is selected for enrolment in a particular course offered by the College will have to complete admission procedures and get herself registered within the notified time period.
- Application for admission has to be made on the prescribed form obtained from the office of the Institute, on the designated days (Monday to Friday between 10:00 am and 1:00 pm and again from 1.30 p.m to 3.00 p.m, and Saturday, 10.00 am to 12.00 noon) only. Students may also apply online.
- Application forms are non-transferable.
- Form must be collected in the name of the applicant only.
- Forms should be complete in all respect with colored passport size photo pasted firmly on appropriate box.
- Cost of the Application Form is Rs. 1,300/- only. Online applicants can pay the money (Rs. 1,500/-) through NET Banking, Debit Card, or Credit Card

ELIGIBILITY

1. Only female candidates are eligible for admission to the B.Sc (Hons) courses.
2. Candidates must have good knowledge of the English language.
3. A student seeking admission to three year B.Sc (Hons.) in Food Science & Nutrition Management of the Institute must have passed the 10+2 examination of any recognized Board / Council recognized by Jadavpur University in four recognized subjects of which at least one is English and securing at least 50% marks in the aggregate. Selection of the subjects will be based on the course opted for and shall be at the discretion of the Management.
4. Foreign Students may be admitted as Jadavpur University norms

SELECTION PROCEDURE

1. Candidates eligible for the B.Sc (Hons) courses would be short-listed based on the following criteria:

	Marks obtained in best four core subjects in the Class-XII board examination of which at least one must be English. Subjects like EVS, Fashion Studies, Multimedia, Music, Dance, Art, Physical Education and others vernacular subjects will not be considered	100
	Marks will be awarded proportionally to the percentage of marks obtained	
2	Science Subjects / Mathematics in Class XII (must have secured at least pass marks)	15 (for Science) + 15 (for Maths) = 30
	Science with Mathematics – 30 marks	
	Science without Mathematics – 15 marks	
	Non-Science with Mathematics – 15 marks	
	Non-Science without Mathematics – 0 marks	
3	Any formal training in performing or visual arts and /or sports and /or participation in the same at regional / state / national / international levels	20
	*Candidates would have to submit self attested certificates for validation
