RULES & REGULATIONS: DRAPING STUDIO

Entry to the lab is restricted in the absence of a teacher.

Rules

- 1. Students must take off their shoes before entering the lab.
- 2. Students must sit only in their assigned work counters.
- 3. Students must not keep their bags on the table-tops but on the rack provided.
- 4. Students must carry all required sewing equipments for each class in a plastic box; sharing of equipments will not be permitted.
- 5. Students must not carry any plastic packets inside the lab.
- 6. Students must carefully handle all equipments provided by the college and return the same to the teacher after completion of the class.
- 7. Students must keep all the equipments in its correct place.
- 8. Students must use tracing boards for tracing patterns; use of carbon paper is banned.
- 9. Students must carry a personal duster for each class
- 10. Students must keep the lab clean and should not litter the place.
- 11. Students must collect all scraps of paper and fabric leftovers in the dustbins provided.
- 12. Students must clean their tables and work areas before leaving the lab
- 13. Students must keep the machines and dress forms covered when not in use.
- 14. Students should not leave behind any pins or ribbons on the dress form.
- 15. Students should take off their shoes and put them on the rack provided outside the laboratory before entering the computer laboratory.
- 16. Food and /or beverages are strictly prohibited inside the computer laboratory.
- 17. Use of mobile phones is strictly forbidden inside the computer laboratory.
- 18. Students cannot carry any plastic packets inside the lab as it is a plastic free zone.
- 19. Students must ensure that all lights and fans are switched off after the class.
- 20. Students must take care of all belongings; the college cannot be held responsible for the loss of the same.

Note: Students found evading the above orders would be fined and / or an action would be taken against them.
