


About the Event (in 150 words): Cancer is a major cause of mortality and morbidity worldwide. According to the World Health Organization, deaths caused by cancer will increase by 45 per cent between 2008 and 2030. Cervical cancer, oral cancer and breast cancer are the most common forms of cancer among women. Most cancer is terminal and treatment only aggravates the situation with numerous side effects. The film, Before you Die shows how a cancer patient and his family deals with critical situation and is all about how dreams and wishes of terminally ill patient can be fulfilled at the set back of the illness. The trailer of the film was showcased at the college campus along with interaction with the cast and crew of the film.

Objective/s (intended outcomes in 100 words): The main objective of the screening was to educate and sensitize, inspire and elevate the audience about terminal illnesses like cancer.

Content (contextual features and challenging issues in 150 words): Before you Die is a film based on how a cancer patient and her family can handles the crisis and trauma in an exemplary way. It is all set to release on February 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022 on the occasion of World Cancer Day. Mr. Pradip Chopra, Chairman of iLEAD is the story writer and producer of the movie. He has also acted in the film. An interactive session was held with the students after the release of the trailer and title track. All the members present shared their experience of working on this film. They narrated various incidents highlighting the importance of the subject and bringing to light the effects of cancer, which are not only felt by the patient but also the caregivers and doctors who are part of the cancer journey. The movie carries the message that even if birth and death are not in our hands, we can surely make our life a happy, satisfactory and worthy one.
