

About the Event (in 150 words): Faculty development program has been considered as a powerful educational pedagogy that is perceived to help in fostering knowledge and professional skills of faculty. It includes range of activities that enable upgradation of skills and opportunities for teachers. Faculty strength is the main ingredient to enhance professional education and competence. Enriching the same in key domains of teaching, research and other skills is perceived to improve educational environment significantly thereby enhancing the academic performance of learners. Secondly, such programmes aim at enhancing the academic and intellectual environment in the Institutions by providing faculty members with opportunities to pursue research and participate in seminars or conferences or workshops. Preparation of desserts through hands-on experience would also aid in improving intricate culinary and bakery skills.

Content (contextual features and challenging issues in 150 words): The participating faculty members of the department of Management were taught the preparation of Marble cake, Choco-chip cookies and Fruit custard. Prior to the commencement of the same, each member was provided the recipes of the desserts to assist them while preparing. Each recipe was then explained and a demonstration given by Mr. Mitra, who supervised the entire workshop. Members were also provided with an opportunity to prepare the recipes on their own to equip themselves for future preparation. The names of the best presenters of the workshop was declared post the programme. Participants also attained the opportunity of tasting the desserts prepared. The participants of the development programme were innovative food lovers who enthusiastically partook in the workshop.
