About the Event (in 150 words): A special lecture on *khadi* was organized and delivered by Dr. B. Syama Sundari. The lecture highlighted the history of *khadi*, and how charkha became a symbol in our national flag as also its post independence status and future. Dr. B. Syama Sundari briefly spoke on *khadi* as the swadeshi brand ambassador and *khadi* production during partition of Bengal while mentioning Dastkar Andhra Organization promoting handlooms and handicrafts of India.

Objective/s (intended outcomes in 100 words): Khadi over the decades has moved from a freedom fighter's identity fabric to a fashion garment. There is such a high demand for khadi now that this poses a challenge. The main objective of celebrating this day was to make the students aware of khadi.

Content (contextual features and challenging issues in 150 words): Khadi is the oldest and a traditional form of hand spun fabric of India. It is looked upon as our national heritage and Mahatma Gandhi promoted khadi; his birth anniversary is synonymous to the Khadi Day. Creating awareness on khadi will increase its demand, thereby will help weavers get work throughout the year and retain the next generation in khadi production. Reviving this spirit of khadi on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti a special lecture 'Khadi: A cloth and beyond' was organized.


