Venue: Flag unfurling at the college campus and telecast of the event live over zoom.

About the event (in 150 words): Every year Republic Day is celebrated by J.D. Birla Institute to honour the day when the Constitution of India came into effect. When India became independent on August 14, 1947, there was no permanent law for the Indians, and a modified version of the British established, Government of India Act, 1935 was followed. The Constitution of India though was enacted and adopted by the Constituent Assembly on 26th November 1949, now celebrated as the Constitution Day; it actually came into effect two months later on 26th January 1950. January 26th is thus celebrated to commemorate the Indian Constitution replacing the Government of India Act (1935) as the governing document of India.

Objective/s (intended outcomes in 100 words): Republic Day is celebrated at the campus every year to inculcate the values and spirit of Indian Constitution among the students of our Institute. The intended objectives of the event are as follows:

- To celebrate democracy which empowered its citizens to elect their representative for forming the government?
- To pay tribute to the Dr. B.R. Ambedkar and his team who spent many sleepless nights to draft the Constitution.
- To instil pride and patriotic fervour among the students and staff for the rich cultural heritage of India.
- To understand its secure nature and importance of unity in diversity.

Content (Contextual features and challenging issues in 150 words): The College celebrated Republic Day to commemorate seventy-three years since the adoption of our Constitution on Wednesday, 26th January, 2022. Due to closure of college owing to the ongoing Covid pandemic, the event was held in the hybrid mode where students and staff watched the programme online with only some staff at the campus for flag hoisting.



Problems encountered, if any: Technical glitch occurred due to laptop malfunctioning at the last moment.

Note (any other information that is relevant in 150 words): There were some suggestions given by the Principal:

1. Programme shall not commence at odd timings. It shall not start before 09:30 AM. The sequence shall be as follows:
 - a. Welcome by Emcee and briefing of the event.
 - b. Address by Principal
 - c. Songs
 - d. Cultural Programme
 - e. Flag unfurling
 - f. National Anthem
 - g. Refreshment
2. Refreshments to staff members shall be served in tray at the get-together point. For students only, boxes shall be made.
3. Complete rehearsal of the entire programme shall be done at least one day prior to the event to ensure its smooth execution on the final day.
4. All teacher in charge of the event must be assigned specific duties and should only be present at the exact location at the venue. At no point should they form groups and overlook proper execution of the event.
5. All students and staff shall assemble and take their position at the venue on time (at least 10 minutes before the event starts).
6. Proper positioning of students and staff at the venue shall be planned and demonstrated.
7. A Podium with microphone shall be placed at the venue next to the flag.
8. Photographs shall be taken by students under supervision of the teacher in charge students shall be explained the requirement and several shots of every pictures should be clicked for selecting the best. Also for flag hoisting/unfurling, a proper picture without Mr. Rajaram Das, peon in the vicinity must be taken for records.
9. Emcees should be made to rehearse and explained the entire event properly. They should not lost confused.
10. No attendance shall be taken during the event. The event coordinator is responsible for that and cannot delegate this responsibility to anyone else.
