

**About the Event (in 150 words)**: Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, also known as the Father of the Indian Constitution, was a politician, economist, philosopher, anthropologist, polymath, civil rights activist, and social reformer who fought for the Dalit community's rights by speaking out against the Indian caste system. He was born on April 14, 1891. Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, the key architect of India's constitution, was a staunch supporter of women's and labour rights. Because Ambedkar fought for equality throughout his life, his birthday is observed in India as 'Equality Day.' To honour his contribution to India, the 14<sup>th</sup> of April has been observed as Ambedkar Jayanti or Bhim Jayanti in India, since 2015.

The Constitution of India, a unique text with numerous unique aspects, is the world's longest written constitution of any sovereign nation. The original Constitution had 395 articles divided into 22 divisions and eight schedules. It went into force on January 26, 1950, the day India commemorates as Republic Day each year. Due to 100 revisions, the total number of articles has risen to 448..

**Objective/s** (intended outcomes in 100 words): This event was held to educate students about the history of our Constitution, prominent personalities engaged in its development, the meaning of the preamble, fundamental rights and responsibilities, and state policy direction principles. The goal was to ensure that future generations are prepared to uphold constitutional values and democratic principles.

Content (contextual features and challenging issues in 150 words): An Inter-department quiz on Indian Constitution was organized by the Department of Commerce. Two students from each of the Departments of FSNM, TCFS, HD and Commerce participated in this event. Four rounds were conducted - General, Rapid Fire, Buzzar, Audio visual along with a tie-breaker. Ms. Diksha Chowdhury was the emcee of the programme and the quiz was mastered by Ms. Payal Surana and Ms. Neha Choraria. The score board was maintained by Ms. Tanvi Mundra and photography in-charge was Ms. Priyambada Singh. Students from the FSNM Department stood first followed by students form the Commerce Department. Winners were given chocolates.
